RESOLUTION to encourage regional caucus of the Council of Representatives:

Whereas Article III Section 2 of the RPA ByLaws states that “State Representatives from more than one state may agree, by majority vote of such State Representatives, to form multi-state regions for the purpose of addressing interstate issues, accomplishing specific objectives and/or holding Member meetings”;

Whereas the Representatives from the states of California, Nevada and Arizona have made an agreement under this article to form a regional caucus of the RPA Council;

Whereas multi-state regional caucuses from other regions of the country could have a useful role in evaluating and monitoring regional rail transit needs as well as the status and progress of ongoing projects;

Therefore, be it Resolved by the Council:

1. The RPA Council of Representatives encourages the formation of multi-state regional caucuses throughout the country, and
2. Each multi-state caucus so establishes shall deliver a written report and oral summary to each Business meeting of the Council.
